Travel options

By car: safe car park opposite the congress centre (see below)

By plane: Brussels National Airport in Zaventem (Brussels); from there you take a direct train to Ghent, or, alternatively, a train to the Bruxelles Midi - Brussel Zuid (Brussels South) train station where you take a connecting train in the direction of Brugge-Oostende (Bruges-Ostend); get off the train at the Gent Sint-Pieters train station Taking a taxi from Brussels National Airport to Ghent is not something we would recommend, as you'll pay over 100 EUR.

By train: TGV or Thalys with destination "Bruxelles Midi - Brussel Zuid" train station (Brussels South); from there you take a direct train to Ghent; get off the train at the Gent Sint-Pieters train station Taxis are available at the main entrance of Gent Sint-Pieters train station; these will take you to any of the hotels in Ghent in 10 to 15 minutes, or the Congress Centre "Het Pand"

Congress Centre

The Congress Centre "Het Pand", a Dominican monastery of the 13th century, is now part of the patrimonium of the Ghent University. Address: Het Pand, Onderbergen I, 9000 Ghent, Belgium - http://www.ugent.be/het-pand/en

How to get there

By train: From the Gent St-Pieters train station: tram I (every 6 minutes) or tram 24 (every 20 minutes); get out at "Korenmarkt" (and cross the bridge for the congress centre and most hotels on the list)

By car: The public parking lot P7 "Sint-Michiels" is opposite the congress centre "Het Pand", and is safe (video surveillance)
